

First milestone for The Fontenay

Hamburg's 5-star hotel has been offering modern luxury on the Alster for five years now

On 19 March 2018, The Fontenay hotel on Hamburg's Outer Alster opened for business. Since then, an average of 3,000 guests a month have enjoyed an overnight experience at Hamburg's currently only Leading Hotel of the World. The Fontenay is the image of a new modern luxury hotel - uniquely interpreted through its extraordinary architecture, a tailor- made interior as well as an exclusive location experience that balances nature and urbanity. The Fontenay soon enjoyed great popularity. With an occupancy rate of almost 90 percent on weekends and over 60 percent during the week. The hotel not only attracts leisure guests but is also a popular centrally located hotel for business guests. The decisive difference in this segment is due to its generous room sizes:

The deluxe rooms of The Fontenay range from 43 to 46 square metres, the largest suite - The Fontenay - offers a Hamburg stay in 200 square metres of luxury.

The "City Hotelresort" - framed by 14,000 square metres of windows - is located in the middle of a green area. The flowing design of the hotel building, consisting of three conjoined circles, based on the idea of Hamburg architect Jan Störmer, symbolises a constant connection to each other. The design, the colours and the extravagance of the hotel's architecture skilfully underline the appreciation of Hamburg as a location and convey an immediate feel-good experience to the guest.

"The Fontenay has fully arrived in the Hanseatic city and has established itself - that makes me proud! Demand is high and the initial stumbling blocks - especially during the hotel closure in the Corona period - have been overcome. With renewed strength, my team and I are now experiencing a more conscious normality. I am very happy to be able to welcome and inspire guests from the WHOLE world in Hamburg," says Thies Sponholz, the Managing Hotel Director of The Fontenay.

For the first (small) anniversary, Executive Chef Patissier Marco D'Andrea is creating a large birthday cake that every hotel guest can "nibble" on.



The Fontenay offers a host of culinary experiences all year round. In the all-day restaurant "Parkview" on the ground floor, with summer terrace and a direct view of the Alster, the new day begins with an extensive breakfast buffet - made from regional ingredients. Over the course of the day, the menu shifts to seasonal and cosmopolitan cuisine, and on warm summer evenings, the unpretentious garden restaurant becomes a gastronomic hotspot.

The culinary experience of star chef Julian Stowasser in the fine-dining restaurant "Lakeside" on the 7th floor is of the highest precision. The changing menu selection is bold, wild, delicate and elegant - in short, delicious and full of passion.

And guests enjoy a "Fontenay's Finest" including the 320° panoramic view in the "Fontenay Bar" on the 6th floor of the hotel. The crew behind bar manager Rocco Tolomeo are inspired by mixing techniques and flavours from all over the world and invite guests to creatively romp on the playground of current drink trends and tastes.

"The Fontenay" - that's 5 years of imposing architecture, premier league culinary arts, warm hospitality and modern luxury experience.

The Fontenay is a reflection of modern Hamburg - a homage to the Hanseatic city. Located directly on the Outer Alster, this "Modern Classic" unites urban nature and cosmopolitan lifestyle in a special way. The fascinating, sculptural architecture houses 130 luxurious rooms and suites, many with a view of the Alster. The heart of the hotel is a glazed inner courtyard planted with trees and the imposing 27m-high enclosed atrium. Casual bar culture can be found with a dream view of the Alster in the Fontenay Bar. For meetings and events, four function rooms with 48 sqm - 220 sqm and daylight are available. Above the rooftops of Hamburg, you can experience an exclusive wellness world with indoor/outdoor pool on 1,000m². The hotel is a member of The Leading Hotels of the World.
