LAKESIDE RESTAURANT NOW AMONGST THE STAR-RATED RESTAURANTS IN HAMBURG

The Guide Michelin, one of the most important international reference guides for hotels and restaurants, has revealed its ratings of the best restaurants in Germany. The Fontenay is a reflection of modern Hamburg – an homage to the Hanseatic City. Situated on the banks of Lake Alster, this ‘Modern classic’ combines urban nature with a cosmopolitan way of life. The intriguing, sculptural architecture is flooded with light and accommodates 130 luxurious rooms and suites. The hotel will have an inner courtyard planted with trees and surrounded by glass, as well as an impressive 27 square meter (290 square foot) high atrium at the heart of the building. In the ground-floor garden restaurant, guests will discover a diverse menu. A relaxed atmosphere can be found at The Fontenay Bar, which will feature a spectacular 320° panoramic view across the lake. Situated on the seventh floor is the gourmet restaurant. Four function rooms offering 48 square meters (516 square feet) to 220 square meters (2368 square feet) and plenty of natural light are available for conferences and events. High above the roofs of Hamburg, guests can experience an exclusive 1,000 square meter spa (10,764 square foot), including an indoor/outdoor pool.
